Commitment to achieving Net Zero

Giant Group is committed to achieving UK Net Zero emissions by 2045.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured in the UK.

Baseline Year: 1st June 2022 – 31st May 2023

Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations.

Giant Group has utilized the data from our ESOS reporting requirements relating to the baseline year 1st June 2022 to 31st May 2023 utilising the billing from the London office plus our homeworking population (which is the bulk of our staff). All other offices the data is included in a service charge. We will seek to remedy this for the next review.

Scope 1

Giant Group do not own any company vehicles and do not own any office space. A calculation was made for gas and electricity used whilst Giant Group employees worked from home in the Baseline year. This was calculated using the average data method produced by EcoAct in partnership with Lloyds Banking Group and NatWest Group¹. The Carbon Trust Footprint Calculator² was then used to calculate emissions. Giant Group’s HR provided the numbers of staff we had working from home over the period 150 at the start of the Baseline period to 158

at the end of the Baseline period resulting in an average for the year of 154 Homeworkers. All UK Homeworking employees were considered in the calculation for the period with the average over the year used for the calculation. The calculation was made assuming that all personnel worked full time, 7.5 hours a day, 240 days of the year.

Scope 2

For electricity the data source used was the June 22 to May 23 Landlords Billing for London. The total electricity consumption was 22,066.03 kWh.

In addition, Giant Group's HR provided the numbers of staff we had working from home over the period 150 at the start of the Baseline period to 158 at the end of the Baseline period producing an average of 154 which was used for the calculations. The calculation was made assuming that all personnel worked full time, 7.5 hours a day, 240 days of the year.

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All other offices have the power consumption included in the service charge and therefore is deemed out of Scope as Giant Group do not have financial or operational control because this is dealt with by the Landlord in every case.

Gas consumption was deemed immaterial by the Landlord. The Carbon Trust Footprint Calculator² was then used to calculate the emissions.

Scope 3

Employee commuting was considered out of scope due to the small number of staff commuting and not using public transport this will be reviewed at next report and if deemed in scope at that time will be calculated using the method documented in the Greenhouse Gas Protocol, Technical Guidance for Calculating Scope 3 Emissions³.

Giant Group has a policy of using public transport for all Business Travel and as such for the purposes of this report Business Travel was not included. This will be reviewed for the next report

Due to the nature of business performed by Giant Group, there are no Upstream transportation and distribution and Downstream transportation and distribution.

Waste generated in operation is deemed out of Scope as GIANT do not have financial or operational control because this is dealt with by the Landlord in every case.

Annual Emissions (June 2023 – May 2024)

From April 2023 Giant Group has operated exclusively from serviced office locations (co-working spaces). Giant Group does not have financial or operational control over energy consumption at these sites as costs are bundled into service charges managed by the respective operators.

Accordingly, Scope 2 building emissions for the current reporting year are 8,561 kgCO₂e. The homeworker calculation has been updated using the same methodology as the baseline year (EcoAct average data method, Carbon Trust Footprint Calculator), with headcount remaining consistent at an average of 154 homeworkers for the period.

<p>Note: The reduction from 12,308 kgCO₂e (baseline) to 8,561 kgCO₂e reflects the closure of the London leased office in April 2023. Homeworker emissions are calculated using the same methodology as the baseline year. Scope 2 building emissions are 8,561 kgCO₂e as Giant Group does not have financial or operational control over energy at its serviced office locations.</p>	

Emissions reduction targets

In order to progress to achieving UK Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

- Work with our office Landlords to aim to source 100% renewable electricity for the buildings Giant Group occupy.
- Work with our office Landlords to assess if kgCO₂e Waste generated in operations can be measured.
- Continue encouraging business travel reduction and ensure business travel only takes place when deemed essential and is only done via public transport.
- Encourage suppliers to adopt a science-based carbon reduction target by 2045
- Review certified, offsetting solutions for emissions we are unable to eliminate.
- Review implement reporting on employee commuting and employees working from home to then re-baseline using data from 2024/2025 to ensure accuracy of reporting data

We project that carbon emissions will increase in the short term due to the addition of additional data sources to better define our baseline as well as projected business growth over the next three years but then will decrease over the next 20 years to 0 kgCO₂e by 2045 as Giant Group work towards achieving UK Net Zero. This is a reduction of 100%.

Carbon Reduction Projects completed

2024 initiatives:

The following environmental management measures and projects were completed:

- Encouraged business travel reduction and ensure business travel only takes place when deemed essential and via Public Transport only
- Implemented a Sustainability (ESG) Steering Committee
- Implemented Microsoft Teams and other online solutions to maximise online meetings rather than face to face, reducing the need for travel

Carbon Reduction Projects planned

2025/26 initiatives:

The following environmental management measures and projects are planned to be undertaken or implemented following this baseline:

- Encourage business travel reduction and ensure business travel only takes place when deemed essential and via Public Transport only
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- Establish an ESG Focus Group for continuous improvements
- Implement improved reporting on employee commuting and employees working from home

It is anticipated that our emissions will increase as our headcount increases in line with business growth, our emissions will then start to reduce as we work to drive down our carbon emissions through collaboration with our Landlords and our Staff.

- Implement improved reporting on employee commuting to bring into Scope employees commuting to on-demand workspaces.
- Continue to work with our Giant Group personnel to raise awareness around sustainability.
- Aim to become UK Carbon Neutral in 2045.
- Progress SBTi target-setting process, including internal data collection and submission



- preparation, with formal submission by end of 2026.
- Engage Landlords at all occupied sites to obtain disaggregated energy consumption data to improve baseline accuracy.

Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard⁴ and uses the appropriate Government Greenhouse Gas Reporting Conversion Factors⁵.

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements, and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard⁶.
